For teachers to access Portal, they will need a username and password, which can be set up by their Examinations Officer.

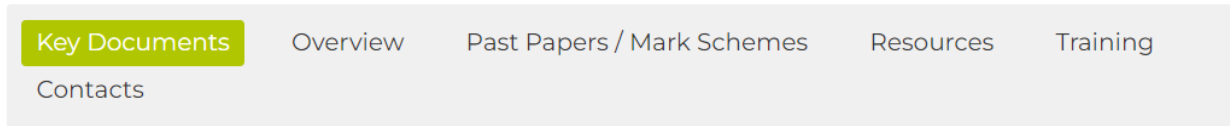
