Assessment Feedback Package

Our new Assessment Feedback Package for 2023-24 is an opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of how assessments are marked or moderated.

Exam Results Analysis

In addition to this, you can still access the Exam Results Analysis to help you understand your students' results and develop their exam skills. Exam Results Analysis on the <u>secure</u> <u>website</u> allows you to compare your students' performance on each question with that of the candidature overall, letting you see where they have done well and where there might be room for improvement. To do this, under the 'Results' tab, click on 'View/Print Item Level Data' or 'View/Print Centre Performance' for comparable data.



Free Access to Candidate Scripts

This year, Schools and colleges who deliver our qualifications will now be able to access candidates' marked scripts from Results Day via our <u>Secure Website</u>. These will be available for all external assessments for Summer 2023, including all GCSEs, AS, A level and Vocational Qualifications. Each script will be available as a PDF and will include the marks and any comments made by our trained examiners to help you review the performance of your learners. These can also be useful classroom aids, to show current learners strengths and common pitfalls that they should consider in future assessments.

ACCESS TO PAST PAPERS, MP3 FILES AND MARK SCHEMES

Here is a reminder how to access the materials for Eduqas MFL GCSE/GCE on the secure website:

Log on to the <u>WJEC Secure Website</u>. At the top of the screen click on the 'Resources' drop-down menu and select 'Past Papers and Marking Schemes'. This will take you to a filter page. Please select the following:

- Subject French / German / Spanish
- Brand Eduqas
- Level GCSE / GCE
- Type of document All
- Year All
- Language English

Access to the secure website is given by Exams Officers as they are the primary account holders for centres. Papers and mark schemes are stored on the secure website for 9 months after the end of an exam series before being released onto the public website.



MODERN FOREIGN LANGUAGE GCSE FOR 2024

It's essential that our new modern foreign language (MFL) qualifications meet the needs of teachers and learners. With this in mind, and after receiving feedback from Ofqual, we have decided to make changes to our previously submitted draft specification.

This will mean a short delay to the accreditation of our new MFL GCSEs, but our top priority is ensuring that the qualifications we design are right for teachers and learners.

Our focus remains on developing specifications that are accessible, flexible and relevant, and we will continue to work closely with Ofqual on developing the new qualifications.

We will provide further updates when available. There will also be a free online event, designed for teachers preparing to deliver the new qualification, for first teaching from September 2024. You can find more information on our <u>website</u>.
