#### 1. Arrangements for summer 2023

There will be no adaptations for Summer 2023 so all assessments/examinations will take place as standard practice.

Component 2 – Food preparation and Nutrition in Action

NEA 1 - The food investigation to be released on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 NEA2 - The food preparation assessment to be released on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 - this will return to being 3 dishes plus accompaniments.
