### Subject webpage

The Eduqas GCSE Latin <u>subject webpage</u> on the Eduqas website is the starting place for anyone teaching the specification and contains a range of official documentation relating to the qualification including the specification, sample assessment materials and past papers.

#### **Portal**

The secure <u>portal</u> gives teachers access to past papers and marking schemes ahead of their publication on the public website.

For teachers to access the portal, they will need a username and password, which can be set up by their Examinations Officer.

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

Component 3B - Roman Civilisation.


#### Past papers on Portal (shortly after end of exam series)

### 3. Marking Schemes




### Marking schemes on Portal (from Results day)

# 5. Exemplar Materials





#### **Exam Results Analysis**



Exam Results Analysis can be used by teachers to:


- Evaluate their own performance against specification norms.
- Identify strengths and weaknesses for a candidate/ cohort and suggest areas of improvement.
- Assist individual candidates in improving their own performance.

It can be accessed on Portal and allows you to compare your students' performance on each question with that of the candidature overall, letting you see where they have done well and where there might be room for improvement. To do this, under the 'Results' tab, click on 'View/Print Item Level Data' or 'View/Print Centre Performance' for comparable data.




## 10. Component 3A - resources for 2026 and 2027 exams


