Entry Codes

All learners taking this GCSE History qualification must be entered for four options in total: 2 options for Component 1 (from British Studies in Depth and Non-British Studies in Depth) and 2 options for Component 2 (from Period Studies and Thematic Studies). Please note that entries for the Depth Studies must be from different historical eras. The Appendix within the [Specification](#) lists the permitted combinations of options. In addition, all learners must be entered for the qualification cash-in.

Results Information

A range of information is available to centres after each examination series via the secure site – www.wjecservices.co.uk – under the 'RESULTS' tab.

This information includes **Summary of Subject Results** – providing a final mark and grade for all candidates who sat a particular paper or qualification. **Component Marks (Linear)** – listing the overall mark, grade and breakdown at component level for each candidate at each qualification. It also shows you where the grade boundaries sit and the aggregate of each paper. **Component Marks** – this option shows you where in the grade the candidate has fallen for a particular paper. **Centre Performance** – this provides a table which compares the results of your centre to every other.
