Job title:	Junior Test Engineer

The Junior Test Engineer will be responsible for improving the quality of software and systems by testing all software development across the organisation. The post holder will ensure they adhere to the standards, guidelines, test plans and test execution, in coordination with the Lead Test Engineer, IT Development and BA colleagues. Working closely with internal stakeholders, the role will include reducing development errors, improving quality, and encouraging ownership of delivered services across the organisation. The post holder will also play a role in putting into major software projects, ensuring solutions meet the needs of the business.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:	
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#### General

- Collaborate with the Lead Test Engineer to ensure the quality of work and reporting of issues is maintained and documented, often working as part of a multi-disciplinary team focused on user needs and user-centred design.
- Collaborate with developers and subject matter experts, analysing trade-offs between usability and performance needs.
- Be aware of test scope, approach, risks and assumptions across DevOps and agile testing.

#### Scripting

- In conjunction with the Lead Test Engineer and Solution Leads, Developers and the BA team. review Requirements and Technical Design documents to derive Manual Test Scripts and User Journeys in accordance with development specifications.
- With support from the Lead Test Engineer, ensure that Test Scripts are detailed, comprehensive, well-structured and documented according to the Test Team's processes.
- Gain experience of identifying, recording, documenting and tracking bugs using the Test Management system (currently Xray in Jira), to mitigate risks to WJEC.
- With assistance from the Lead Test Engineer, set up test data, estimate testing activities and contribute to Test documentation.
- Take part in all phases of testing and the testing activities (e.g., Regression, User Acceptance and Exploratory testing) within a development project.
- Work with the Lead Test Engineer to automate Test Scripts using Open-Source technology.
- Assist in the adoption of automated testing principles to improve efficiencies, quality and reduce time to BAU

#### Agile

• Gain hands-on test experience within Agile projects, with an understanding of the Sprint, CI and release testing lifecycles.

#### **Test Approach**

- Be aware of testing deliverables and achievement of testing milestones during a project.
- Work in an Agile environment during each testing phase of a project.
- Maintain an awareness of testing alternatives so that the most effective testing strategy can be selected and agreed with the Lead Test Engineer.
- Work with the Lead Test Engineer to identify and implement test tools/software to aid and improve the testing processes and their implementation.
- With support from the Solutions Delivery Team, maintain an up-to-date understanding of the current WJEC technology base, industry trends and emerging standards, e.g., AWS, SQL, iSeries, Talend, Bitbucket.

#### Other

- To understand and comply with all WJEC policies and procedures detailed in the Staff Handbook; in particular, ensuring you understand your role and responsibilities in relation to Safeguarding, Information Security, GDPR, Confidentiality, Welsh language and Health, Safety and Environment.
