## SUMMARY OF ASSESSMENT

### Summer 2022 only

**Component 1: Introduction to physical education**  
Written examination: 2 hours  
60% of qualification

Learners will be assessed through a range of short and extended questions. The questions will be based on stimuli/sources.

**Component 2: The active participant in physical education**  
Non-exam assessment  
40% of qualification

This component is internally assessed and externally moderated.

Learners will be assessed in **two** different activities in the role of performer in any two activities. This may be two individual, team or a combination of both. Learners will be further assessed through a written analysis and evaluation of their personal performance in **one** of their chosen activities.

40% of qualification
